### By Plane

Arriving by plane into Ireland, you will most probably land at <u>Dublin Airport</u> which is located north of Dublin city, near Swords in the administrative county of Fingal. Dublin Airport is also the headquarters of Ireland's flag carrier <u>Aer Lingus</u>, the regional airlines <u>Stobart Air</u> and <u>CityJet</u> as well as those of low-cost carrier <u>Ryanair</u>. The airport offers a short and medium haul network, domestic services to regional airports in Ireland, and long-haul services to the

United States, Canada, the Middle East and Hong Kong. Alternatively you can arrive via Shannon Airport and make your way by public transport to Dublin.

# **Bus from Airport**

Several bus companies connect Dublin Airport to Dublin city centre, such as <u>Airlink Express</u> (Busses 757 and 747) which brings passengers directly to <u>Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin)</u> and <u>Aircoach</u> (Bus 700) which operates a service which passes UCD. The Aircoach bus stop at UCD is located just outside the main N11 (Stillorgan Road) entrance).

### **Taxi from Airport**

Taxis are available from the forecourts directly outside Terminal 1 & Terminal 2. Passengers should follow Taxi signage to the designated taxi ranks. A taxi dispatcher is available at either taxi rank if you require any further information or assistance.

### By Ferry and Train

<u>Dublin Connolly Station</u> is connected by bus to <u>Dublin Port</u> and ferries run by <u>Irish Ferries</u> and <u>Stena Line</u> to Holyhead for connecting trains on the North Wales Coast Line to Chester, Crewe and London Euston. Dublin Connolly to Dublin Port can be reached via Amiens Street, Dublin into Store Street or by <u>Luas</u> via <u>Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin)</u> where <u>Dublin Bus</u> operates services to the Ferry Terminal.

### **By Train**

Heuston and Dublin Connolly stations are the two main railway termini in Dublin. Operated by larnród Éireann, the Dublin Suburban Rail network consists of five railway lines serving the Greater Dublin Area and commuter towns such as Drogheda and Dundalk in County Louth, Gorey in County Wexford, and extending as far as Portlaoise and once a day, Newry. One of the five lines is the electrified Dublin Area Rapid Transit (DART) line, which runs primarily along the coast of Dublin, comprising 31 stations, from Malahide and Howth southwards as far as Greystones in County Wicklow. Commuter rail operates on the other four lines using Irish Rail diesel multiple units. It is a short walk from Dublin Connolly Station to O'Connell Street, where the Dublin Bus numbers 11 and 46A can be boarded for UCD. The route 145 provides a direct route from Heuston Station to Belfield via the city centre. For further information, visit Larnróad Eireann (Irish Rail).

### By Tram

The Dublin new light rail system, often described as a tram system, the Luas, consists of two interconnecting lines; the Red Line links the Docklands and city centre with the south-western suburbs of Tallaght and Saggart, while the Green Line connects northern inner city suburbs and the main city centre with suburbs to the south of the city including Sandyford and Brides Glen. Together these lines comprise a total 67 stations and 44.5 kilometres (27.7 mi) of track.

## By Bus

Dublin is served by a network of nearly 200 bus routes which cover the city and suburbs. The majority of these are provided by <u>Dublin Bus</u>, with a modest number having been transferred to <u>Go Ahead Ireland</u> in 2018, but a number of smaller companies also operate. Fares are generally calculated on a stage system based on distance travelled. There are several different levels of fares, which apply on most services. A <u>"Real Time Passenger Information"</u> system was introduced at Dublin Bus bus stops in 2012. Electronically displayed signs relay information about the time of the next bus' arrival based on its GPS determined position. The National Transport Authority is responsible for integration of bus and rail services in Dublin and has been involved in introducing a pre-paid smart card, called a <u>Leap card</u>, which can be used on all of Dublin's public transport services.

<u>Dublin Bus</u> provides a range of services to and from the Belfield campus. See the <u>Dublin Bus UCD</u> interactive map

<u>Bus Éireann</u> provides a nationwide bus service with most major areas having a regular link to Dublin. The majority of Dublin services terminate in <u>Busáras (Central Bus Station, Dublin)</u> from where it is a short walk to O'Connell Street for connecting buses to UCD. Several Bus Éireann services from the Greater Dublin area directly serve the UCD Belfield Campus during morning peak times.

<u>Aircoach</u> operates a bus service from Dublin Airport to Leopardstown/ Sandyford/Stillorgan which passes UCD.


